This privacy policy sets out how Green Gas Certification Scheme uses and protects any information that you give Green Gas Certification Scheme when you use this website.

Green Gas Certification Scheme is committed to ensuring that your privacy is protected. Should we ask you to provide certain information by which you can be identified when using this website, then you can be assured that it will only be used in accordance with this privacy statement.

What we collect

We will collect personal details such as your name, email address and telephone number either from information that you have given us whilst using the website or from any personal correspondence with us, such as emails. We also automatically collect information about your visit to our site using Google Analytics. This information is used to make your visit to our site more efficient, and to help us follow browsing preferences on our site so that we can make regular improvements.

What we do with the information we gather

How we use cookies

We occasionally issue session cookies when strictly necessary for the operation of the website.
